Level: Complete beginner to beginner (CEFR: A1).

Higher level students will attend the lessons of an appropriate Summer Course class.

ENROLLMENT PROCEDURE

- 1. Fill in the application form and send it to us by email or fax.
- 2.We will email you the URL of our level check test. Complete the test within 30 min. Remember to choose if you would like an interview. Even if you choose not to have an interview, we may ask you to do so based on the result of the level check test. If you haven't learned Japanese, you don't have to take the level check test.
- 3.We will arrange a Skype or telephone interview for those who request one. Otherwise, we'll determine the course and level suitable for you based on the online level check test.
- 4. Pay the fees to school (see PAYMENT). Once we confirm your payment, we will secure your place.

June 1, 2018

It may be possible to accept applications even after the above deadline. Please consult with the school for the latest status. In case of cancellation after the course start date, KAI will retain the full amount unless the school cancels the course.
